Who is eligible for Financial Aid?

Financial Aid eligibility is dependent upon the degree of need as verified by this form and supporting documents.

How do I apply for Financial Aid?

What does a Financial Aid scholarship cover?

If eligible, one partial or full scholarship will be awarded per household. Scholarships are awarded based on eligibility and may cover up to a maximum of \$70 for any group class.
